In partnership with WeWork, Spaces & Stories provides exclusive access to some of the city's best buildings, activating them as locations for the first time.

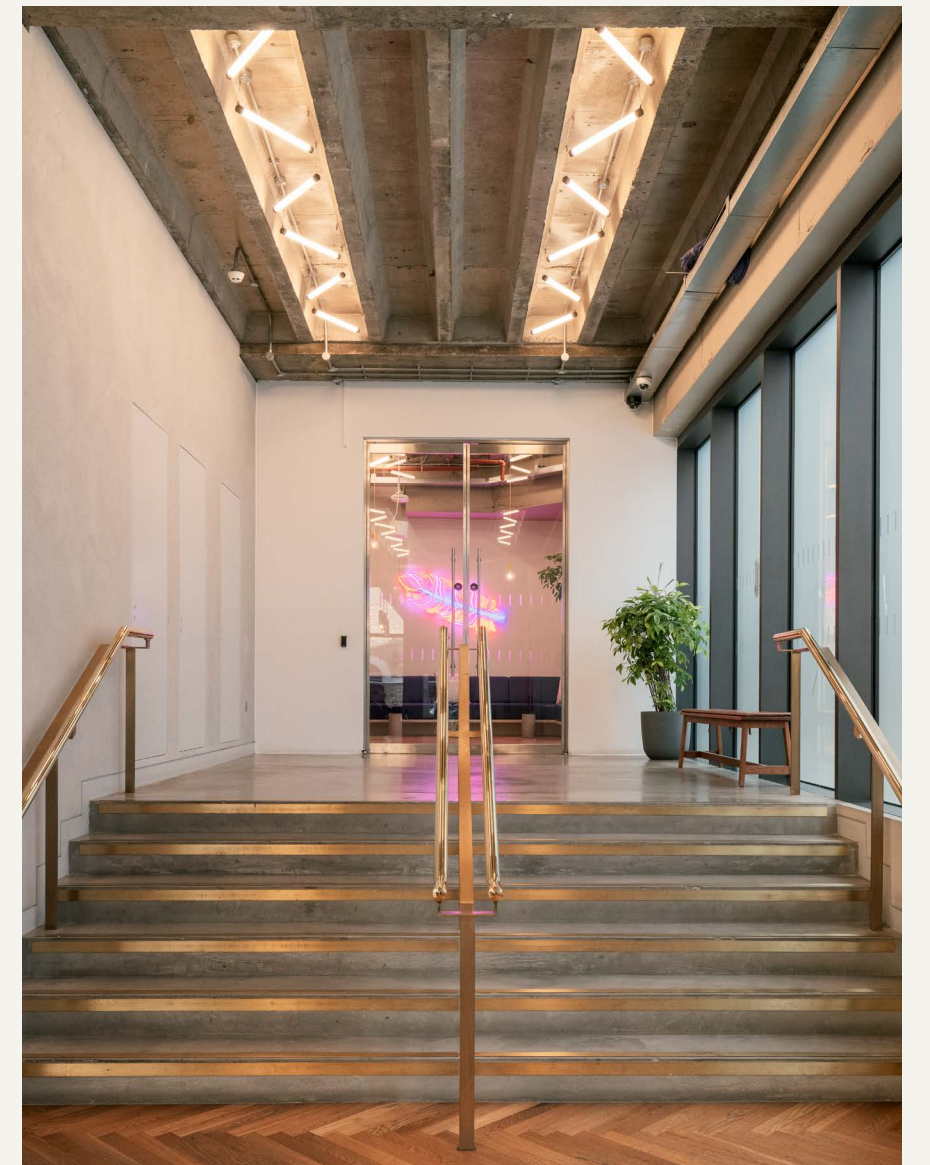

Spaces



Available 7 days a week, with ever-changing offerings, these locations strive to provide each production with the perfect backdrop for their vision.





Office

For a ready-made office setting, choose from a range of 50 large open-plan spaces or smaller intimate offices, suiting a variety of shoot requirements.

These fully private workspaces come pre-furnished with tables and chairs, offering double or single height ceilings. Across the portfolio London views are available as well as additional meeting rooms to be activated for hair & make up, green rooms and catering.

Apartment/Loft

Expect city views, floor-to-ceiling windows and an array of loft style architectural features, the Office Filming Locations boast a number of private apartment style spaces that have never been used as shoot locations before.

Choose from design features including exposed brick walls, high ceilings, and fully furnished spaces to depict urban lofts and apartments.

Foyer/Lifts

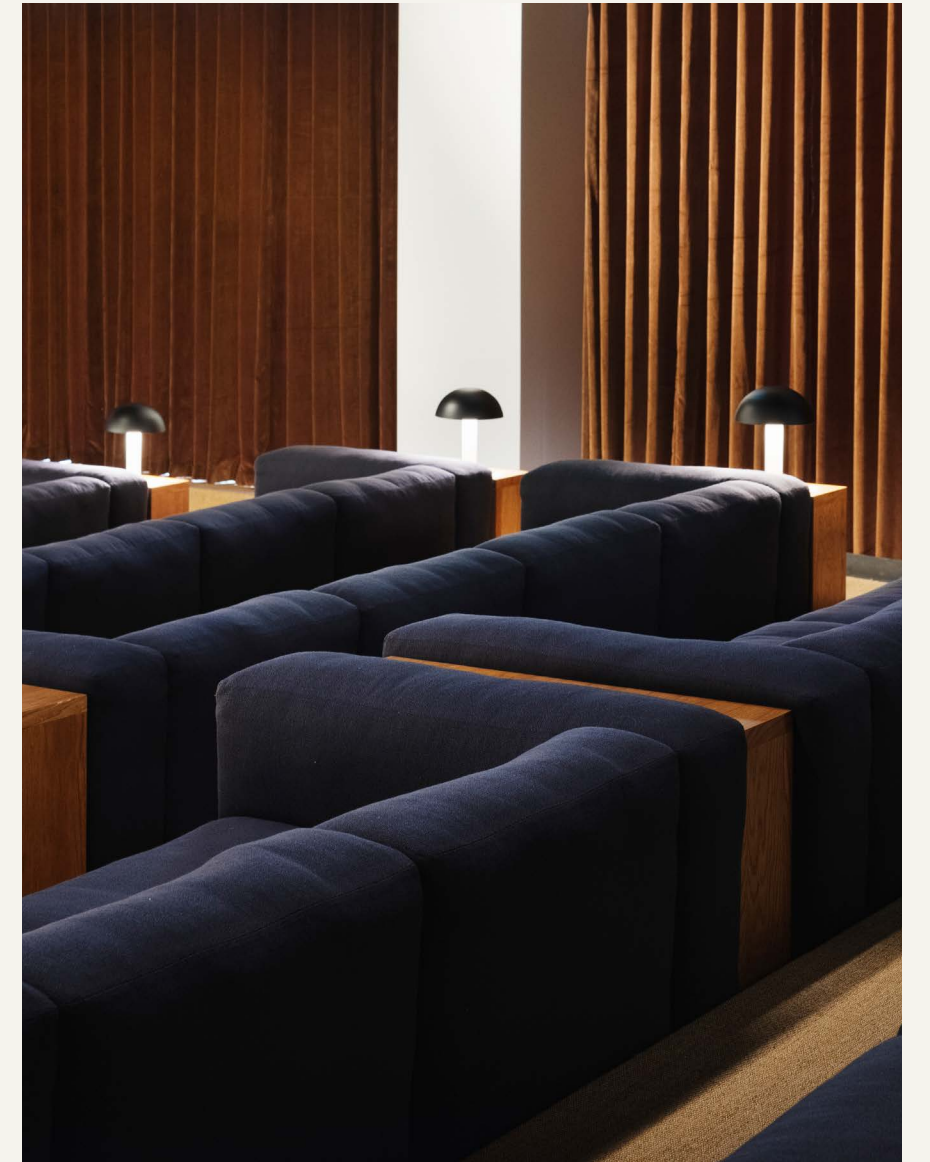
Across our Office Filming Locations there are a range of receptions, foyers and lifts to act as an entryway, office foyer, apartment foyer and more.

Each adorned with different decor and views and previously unused for filming or shoots. Available for weekend bookings only.

York Road

York Road is WeWork's flagship property in Waterloo, with three distinct spaces available for filming. The largest is an impressive double-height glass space on the 16th floor with an expansive rooftop terrace and views over London. Two purpose-built areas – a luxury auditorium-style screening room and a hidden speakeasy – offer a premium setting for screenings and intimate scenes.







16th Floor & The Terrace

The 16th Floor is the quintessential London skyscraper setting with double-height windows and breathtaking 180-degree views of the city including landmarks such as the Houses of Parliament, Battersea Power Station and The London Eye.

It is a modern, highly polished space with an open-plan layout that could be dressed for a variety of scenes. The space has direct access to a large outdoor terrace, with expansive views and subtle glass balustrades. As a versatile space with furniture and bar infrastructure, the 16th Floor can be dressed for restaurant, bar or penthouse apartment scenes.

The Speakeasy

This intimate lounge area is hidden behind a bookcase in the building's library. Perfect for staging a luxurious office or the home of a high net-worth individual. The built-in blinds transform the space into an atmospheric environment that is not tied to a specific location or period.

The Auditorium

On the 8th floor of the building, The Auditorium is a custom-built luxury cinema. With luxurious sofas and fully lined with curtains, the space evokes old-fashioned glamour in a mid-century style.

Churchill Place

A 20-storey tower in the centre of Canary Wharf, Churchill Place is home to some of the UK's biggest names in business. We have exclusive access to the building's main space: an impressive triple-height glazed atrium that evokes the aspiration of modern city life. The adjoining room provides fully flexible space that can be transformed for filming or production.







The Atrium

The Atrium is a triple-height space with floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking Canary Wharf. Defined by clean architectural lines, glass panelling and modern monochrome furniture, The Atrium feels understated and luxurious, with the versatility to create a number of moods and environments.

The Conference Space

Bright and airy, The Conference Space is a versatile space with access to The Atrium. It has floor-to-ceiling windows, and a range of furniture makes it well suited to office and classroom scenes. It can also be activated as a dressing room or crew base when shooting in The Atrium.

The Monument

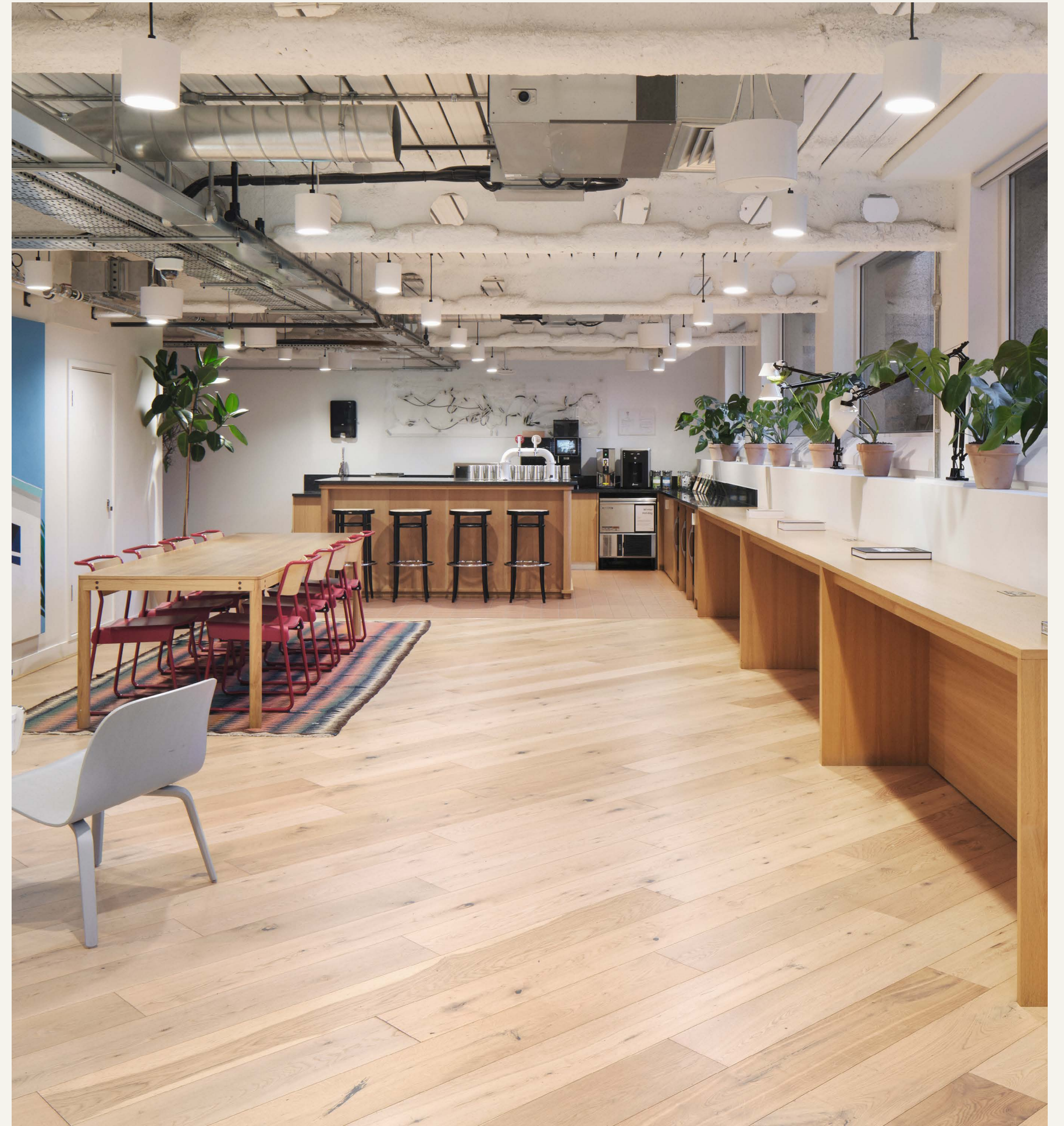
The Rooftop has 360-degree views, providing an immersive environment among the soaring towers and domes of London's most recognisable landmarks, including St Paul's, Tower Bridge and The Shard. Located on the 9th floor of the building, The Rooftop boasts over 100 square metres of open-air space in central London. The private rooftop can be transformed for number of scenic outdoor shoots, from rooftop bars and restaurants to city action scenes.





Leadenhall Street

Located in the City of London, Leadenhall Street is a unique space that combines modern interiors with a historic architectural feature. The space is split over two levels, and divided into several zones: with seating areas, games tables, a full pantry and barista station. A chrome spiral staircase connects the two levels, framed by the building's original sixteenth-century chapel wall. The unique character makes it a compelling setting for office and loft scenes.





The Mezzanine

The upper level is a bright, modern open-plan space, with large windows looking onto the historic streets of the city. A modern snack station, barista bar and a range of furnishings make it a simple and flexible setting for workplace, café or restaurant scenes.

The Arc

Accessed via a spiral staircase, The Arc is a flexible, open-plan space with kitchenette, soft furnishings and a games area. With a polished, professional feel, it can be used for a variety of settings, or as a staging and production area for the upper level.

Aviation House

A former chapel in central London, Aviation House is a modern reinterpretation of a historic site. With a private entrance opposite Holborn Station, the site has two distinct locations: the first is the vaulted modern chapel, and the second, an underground speakeasy with a contemporary maximalist aesthetic.







The Chapel

The vaulted ceilings, murals and modular plywood seating bring a bright, contemporary character to the restored chapel. With a mirrored rear wall and hardwood floors, the space is the perfect canvas for staging creative expression of all kinds, from studio to loft scenes.

The Speakeasy

Hidden beneath The Chapel, The Speakeasy provides a spectacular secondary space to this location. Mastering contemporary maximalist design, The Speakeasy combines exceptional natural materials with modernist light fixtures, an olive-green marble terrazzo bar and a suspended mirrored ceiling. It is a fully private space that works well for bar and restaurant scenes as well as art and fashion shoots.
