






Spaces The Directors' Entrance

The venue is accessed through the Directors' Entrance to the south side of the building. Its impressive bronze doors are decorated with original sculptural panels depicting a personification of energy. The entrance leads to a grand Art Deco lobby, which serves as a perfect place for guest registration.






Spaces Directors' Bar

From the Lobby, guests would travel to the Directors' Bar via the staircase or the original lift, before entering this light filled space featuring a large skylight and window. The Directors' Bar serves as the perfect space for reception drinks, serviced from a brandable, purpose-built bar. The room also has space for a satellite cloakroom and could be used as a catering breakout area between conference sessions, or as an exhibition stand area.





Spaces Control Room A

Control Room A is the main event space, serving 220 guests for a standing reception and up to 200 guests seated for dinner. With beautifully restored control panels in situ, a gold-coffered glass ceiling and original Art Deco finishings, it is a unique and highly memorable space. The perfect setting for celebrations and events including receptions, fashion shows and brand launches calling for a distinctive setting.



Floor plan Battersea Power Station: Control Room A








Theatre Style 135 Pax Control Room A




Theatre Style 95 Pax Control Room A




Theatre Style 40 Pax Directors' Bar






Round Table Dinner 200 Pax Control Room A




Round Table Dinner 36 Pax Directors' Bar




Long Table Dinner 76 Pax Control Room A

Neighbourhood

Battersea Power Station is one of London's most recognisable buildings. Built between 1929 and 1935, it sits on the south bank of the River Thames as a legacy to the city's industrial past.

The Power Station lay in disrepair after it was decommissioned in the 1970s. The current redevelopment project involved conservation and restoration of the building's Art Deco.

The Power Station is the heart of the 42-acre development, which provides an innovative place to shop, eat, drink, live, work and play with over 100 shops, restaurants, leisure attractions (including Lift 109) and hundreds of homes for the city's workers. The Grade II listed building encompasses London's most exciting shopping and leisure destination south of the river.
